- Seek opportunities to carry out performance tests early in the lifecycle, 'shift-left' performance activities as far as possible to enable performance engineering when possible
- Determine high level performance test scenarios that need to be executed

- Work with clients on the definition and/or review of Non-Functional requirements on a project
- Undertake Performance Test Proof of Concepts (PoC's) to confirm intended test approach is viable and tool selection is appropriate
- Seek opportunities for continuous improvement and implement solutions that add value client/project

- Experience using a range of Performance Testing tools including LoadRunner/Performance Centre, EggPlant Performance, JMeter, NeoLoad or similar
- Experience of leading performance testing engagements from inception through to successful conclusion
- Ability to identify test environments and data required to support the tests specified, including experience of exploiting cloud options

- Demonstrable aptitude for diagnosing issues and problem solving
- Experience of preparing detailed test plan documents and reports that can be understood by a range of stakeholders, both technical and non-technical
